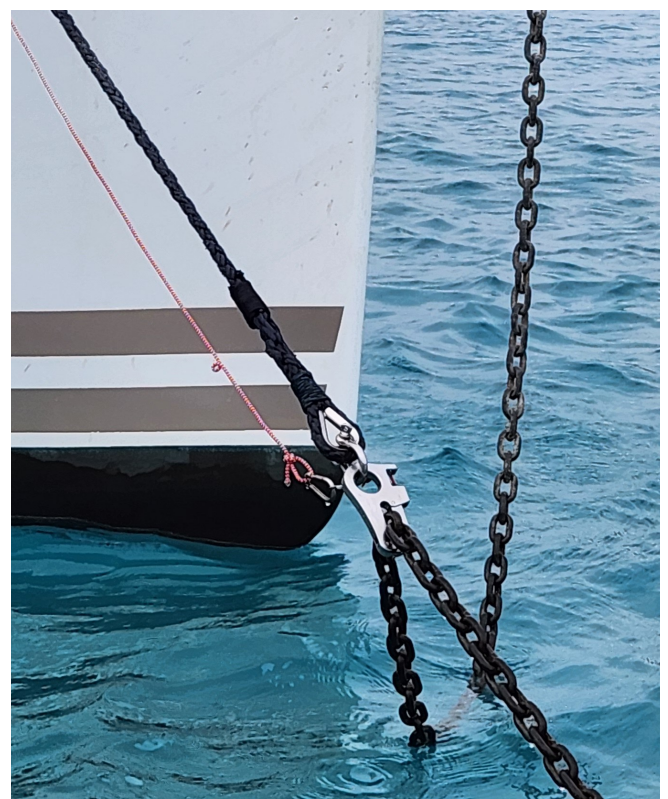
Just **pull the release line** and the snubber detaches instantly. No hauling chain. No struggling at the bow.

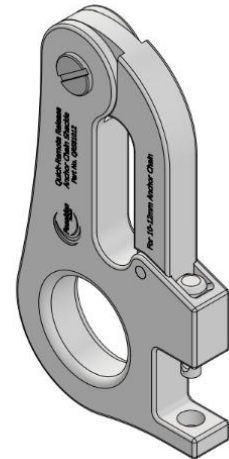
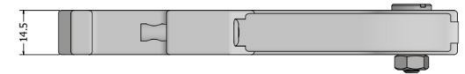
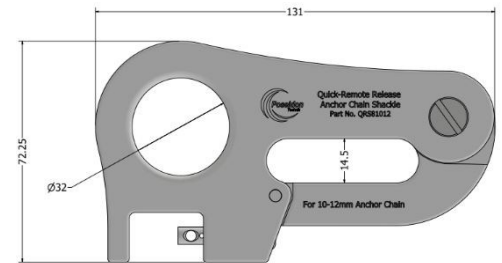

Setup and User Instructions

- 1) The release line should be run parallel to the snubber line which attaches to the bow cleat.
- 2) If you are running the release line back to the cockpit use a small block above the bow cleat and stantion mounted line guides to bring the line fully aft without snagging other lines or deck fittings
- 3) To fit the shackle on the chain lean over the bow and clip it over the chain after the bow roller
- 4) Then run out the anchor chain till the snubber line is taking the strain.
- 5) Allow a little slack in the release line, but not a lot otherwise as the boat swings at night the release line can get wrapped around the snubber line
- 6) When you want to release the snubber a gentle pull is enough in normal conditions. Keep pulling the release line in till the snubber is up on the deck.
- 7) In high winds when there is significant load on the shackle it may be necessary to use the windlass to bring in the chain just enough to take the tension off the shackle. Alternatively use a small amount of forward engine to take the tension of the shackle. Either method works just as well.
